CALL FOR PAPERS

The Office of University Social Responsibility (Oficina RSU) of the University of Extremadura (UEx) together with the European Alliance of Universities for Sustainability EU GREEN coordinated by UEx, in its commitment to promote social responsibility through research and its involvement with society and university groups, presented at the Congress of Young Researchers of Extremadura. The main objective of this Congress is to promote the dissemination of scientific and academic research carried out by young people from Extremadura, and it is open to all those interested in attending or participating by presenting their work. This reinforces the institutional commitment of both UEx and the EU GREEN Alliance to research, sustainability and social well-being, providing their support to turn this Congress into a reference in the academic, scientific and social fields.

It is also a SOLIDARITY CONGRESS, as contributions can be made that will go to a charitable cause linked to the actions of the UEx USR Office.

PURPOSE

1. Bringing academic research closer to society, companies and the general public, whether carried out in a university environment or in another research context outside the University.

2. Supporting young researchers from Extremadura with the event, offering them the opportunity not only to share their research, but also promoting dialogue and synergies between researchers and companies.

3. Using research as a means of solidarity and social commitment to responsible causes.

TO WHOM IS IT ADDRESSED?

PARTICIPANTS AND SPEAKERS

All researchers under 35 years of age who are working at any of the Universities of the EU GREEN Alliance (Atlantic Technological University (Ireland), Högskolan i Gävle (Sweden), Otto-von-Guericke-Universität Magdeburg (Germany), Universidad de Extremadura (Spain), Universidade de Evora (Portugal), Università di Parma (Italy), Universitatea din Oradea (Romania), Université d'Angers (France), Uniwersytet Przyrodniczy we Wrocławiu (Poland), Doctoral or Master's degree students, Professors and Doctors who want to bring their research topic closer to the rest of society and the rest of the community. Each participant may appear as the author of a single individual communication or a maximum of two as co-authors, and must, in any case, participate in the presentation of all those in which he or she appears as author or co-author so that his or her participation in the conference is certified.

A certificate of attendance and participation in the Congress will be issued to all participants, provided that the work has been presented.

PARTICIPANTS ATTENDING

Anyone interested in the Congress may attend at any time, until full capacity is reached, without presenting a communication and only being entitled to a certificate of attendance.

PARTICIPATING COMPANIES

There will be numerous companies or entities, belonging to different sectors and business activities, who will collaborate in discussion panels defined according to the different areas of knowledge.

DEVELOPMENT

BRIEF EXHIBITIONS will be held in which researchers will present research topics that they have developed or are currently working on. The exhibitions will be grouped according to the following areas of knowledge: Arts and Humanities, Sciences, Health Sciences, Social and Legal Sciences, and Engineering and Architecture.

Following the exhibition, business panels will be formed to contribute to the discussion of the works presented, make suggestions, propose actions, etc. In short, an exchange of ideas will take place, contributing to the promotion and improvement of the University-business-society link and to the generation of greater social commitment.

The 2025 Young Researchers Marathon will be designed as a hybrid event with several in-person sessions and at least one online session for those participants who cannot attend in person. Priority will be given in this type of session to those participants who belong to the EU GREEN Alliance. The format of the sessions will be as follows:

- face-to-face sessions: duration 10 minutes
- online session, 5 minutes.

Associated universities are invited to propose a maximum of two people for the online session.

Young researchers from universities belonging to the EU GREEN Alliance can participate in face-to-face sessions, although the costs will be covered by the associated universities.

TOPICS

Since this is a Multidisciplinary Congress, the research topics to be presented will be those corresponding to each researcher, in which they usually work and develop their lines of research, either alone or in the Research Group to which they belong.

REGISTRATION

2. Send an abstract of no more than 600 words, stating the title, author, affiliation, area of knowledge and keywords. In the email, indicate in the subject field YOUNG RESEARCH MARATHON and as file name put SURNAME, NAME. Sending address: <u>dirresuex@unex.es</u>.

3. Once the Congress has been held, complete papers will be requested, according to a certain format and length, in order to compile them in a book with an ISBN and publish them in the University of Extremadura publishing house.
